Types of Feline Vaccines and Their Attributes - aaha.org MEASLES VACCINE: Attenuated Measles Vaccine is a heterologous, single-dose (do not booster) vaccine for administration to young dogs (not less than 6 wk of age and not older than 12 wk of age) as a means of protecting young dogs (only) against canine distemper virus.
