Stevenson died before the case was finalised and Donoghue was awarded a reduced amount of damages from his estate. The outcomes of Donoghue v. Donoghue v Stevenson. Donoghue sued the manufacturer of a bottle of ginger beer that she drank which contained snail remnants. As a result she became ill. The courts in hearing this case found that the manufacturer owed Donoghue a duty of care as she was their neighbour (someone who was affected by your acts or omissions) and they were reckless in
